

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS - WEST OXFORDSHIRE)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING)
(WOODSTOCK) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2018**

The Oxfordshire County Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Section 9 and Part IV Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Various Roads – West Oxfordshire) (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading) (Woodstock) Experimental Order 2018 and shall come into force on the first day of February 2018.
2. (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment.

(2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa.

(3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.
3. The effect of this order and for the duration of this order is to amend temporarily the Oxfordshire County Council (Various Roads, West Oxfordshire) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Permitted Parking) Order 2008 (as amended) "the 2008 Order" as specified in the Schedule to this order.
4. If the provisions of this Experimental Order are made permanent, the measures specified will be added to “the 2008 Order”.
5. The Director for Communities/Infrastructure Delivery of the Council is empowered to modify or suspend this Order or any provision of it pursuant to and in accordance with Section 10(2) of the Act.
6. This Order shall continue in force for a maximum period of 18 months from the date on which it comes into force.

SCHEDULE

Amendments to “the 2008 Order”:

1.)

In **Schedule 10** - ITEM 79 of Prohibition of Loading and Unloading at any time` is temporarily added as follows:

“ITEM 79: WOODSTOCK

Market Place, main carriageway – North side

From a point 3.9 metres east of the east corner of the alleyway adjacent to No.16 Market Place, westwards for a distance of 32.6 metres to the east kerb line of Browns Lane

Market Place, central area

From the northwest corner of the Town Hall westwards for 21.7 metres, then southwards for 10 metres, then eastwards for 36.5 metres, to a point 3 metres west of the southeast corner of the Town Hall

High Street – South side

From a point 0.3 metres west of the arched entry of the Macdonald Bear Hotel, eastwards for a distance of 33.6 metres, to a point 5.1 metres west of the common boundary of Nos.5 and 7.”

2.)

In ITEM 79 of **Schedule 15** `No Waiting at any Time` the entries in respect of Market Place are deleted and replaced as follows:

“ITEM 79: WOODSTOCK

Market Place, main carriageway – North side

From a point 3.9 metres east of the east corner of the alleyway adjacent to No.16 Market Place, westwards for a distance of 32.6 metres to the east kerb line of Browns Lane

Market Place, central area

From the northwest corner of the Town Hall westwards for 21.7 metres, then southwards for 10 metres, then eastwards for 36.5 metres, to a point 3 metres west of the southeast corner of the Town Hall

High Street – South side

From a point 0.3 metres west of the arched entry of the Macdonald Bear Hotel, eastwards for a distance of 33.6 metres, to a point 5.1 metres west of the common boundary of Nos.5 and 7.”

~~(b) South side – from a point 5 metres west of the boundary between Nos. 5 and 7 Market Place westwards for a distance of 28 metres.~~

4. ~~Market Street:~~

~~——— (a) North side:~~

~~(i) from its junction with Oxford Street (A44) westwards for a distance of 9 metres;~~

~~(ii) from a point 3 metres west of the eastern boundary of No. 3 Blandford Court westwards for a distance of 5 metres.~~

~~(b) South side – from its junction with Oxford Street (A44) westwards for a distance of 18 metres~~
