News from the Council

NOTICE REGARDING THE OWL STEPS. The OWL steps have been temporarily closed. The steps are in need of repair and quotes have been obtained. At the Town Council meeting on 16th January 2024 at which these quotes were submitted, it was suggested that there could be an issue with ongoing access to the OWL steps and it was decided that this must be investigated before public money is spent. A vote was taken and it was unanimously decided that, while the Town Council awaits confirmation regarding access rights, it would be best to temporarily close the steps for public safety. More information will be provided when we have it. Thank you for your understanding.

Hensington Road Parking. WODC are doing a survey of parking in Hensington Road - please <u>follow this link</u>. The survey finishes on 12 February.

Botley West. The second phase of consultation on Botley West started on Thursday 30th November 2023 and finishes on Thursday 8th February 2024.

WOODSTOCK HISTORY NOTES

A Right Royal Borough...

There is in the Council's archives a document dated 1461, sealed with a wax impression. The first of Woodstock's seals with which that impression was made is still in the Council's possession – it can be viewed on the first floor of the town's museum.

Because its lettering refers to the *`royal town of Woodstock*` the seal is likely to have been made before Henry VI granted Woodstock its first charter in 1453, thereby transferring it out of the king`s hands and into those of a mayor and corporation.

Not surprisingly, in view of the town's early and long-standing association with England's monarchs, Woodstock's loyalties seem to have remained with the king as evidenced by the names of pubs *The King*'s *Arms* and until recently *The King*'s *Head* (now *Back Lane*).

That other symbol of a town council's authority, the mace, was made during Oliver Cromwell's interregnum in 1655 only to undergo a swift and expedient remodelling in 1660 to include the royal arms in recognition of the restoration of Charles II to the throne.
