1	Introduction The Mayor Cllr Ann Grant welcomed the members of the public and introduced the speakers who were: Calum Miller – MP, Dr Duncan Becker – MB BS MRCP, Cllr Andy Graham – OCC, Roger File – Blenheim Palace, Merylyn Davis Blenheim Palace, and members of the Town Council which were Cllr Ann Grant (Mayor), Cllr Sarah Williams (Deputy Mayor), Cllr John Banbury, Cllr Sharone Panes, Cllr Elizabeth Poskitt. 2.	Questions from the floor Each of the speakers then stated their position on this topic.
3.	Open Forum The Mayor then open the discussion to the floor for questions.
